Admission Started

Danahalaya, a centre dedicated to the formation of formators and the facilitation of psycho-spiritual integration among the priests and the religious, is launching a new Masters level programme clubbing the Diploma programme of Danahalaya with the M.A. Clinical Psychology of a recognised university. The students will simultaneously register for the MA in clinical psychology of IGNOU and the Diploma in Formation of Danahalaya and pursue the formation and courses at the Institute. This programme aims at equipping those in the facilitating ministry to profit the fruits of recent psychological researches integrated with Christian anthropology. As Pope John Paul II said, "the discoveries and achievements purely in the fields of psychology and psychiatry are not capable of offering a truly complete vision of the person. They are not capable of resolving on their own the fundamental questions concerning the meaning of life and the human vocation". Therefore Danahalaya is keen to emphasise an integration of scientific insights of psychology with a sound Christian anthropology.

Course format

In addition to the 12 papers of MA Clinical Psychology IGNOU, Danahalaya introduces Christian Anthropology and its applications in 12 modules in two years (4 semes-

ters). (They are organised in such a way that they will not overburden the students)

- Anthropology of Christian Vocation
- Human Development in Christian perspective
- Personality Styles and Attachment patterns
- Moral Development and Psychology
- Ethics in Psychology and Formation
- Family Psychotherapy and Christian values
- Psycho-sexual integration and Celibacy
- Different therapies like REBT, Gestalt, AMR, TA, NLP
- Dynamics of Religious/Community life
- Psychodynamic Psychotherapy and Accompaniment
- Spirituality of consecrated and priestly life
- Spiritual discernment and Spiritual Direction

- A govt recognised degree in any discipline
- ❖ Basic theological formation
- Sufficient intellectual as well as emotional maturity to pursue the programme offered

This programme is intended for priestly and religious candidates for helping them discern their vocational motivation. The Rectors or Formators can contact Denahalaya to organise such programmes.



Denahalaya, Punnapra, a venture of the Archdiocese of Changanacherry, is an institute dedicated to the formation of the formators founded by Late Rev. Dr. Thomas Thyparampil who was the Director of NVSC, Pune for 12 years, and the Director of Denahalaya for 19 years.

Two year Master Level Course in Formation and Clinical Psychology (MAPF VII) 15 June 2020 to 30 June 2022

Denahalaya aims at giving professional formation to those who aspire to engage in formatory roles such as formators, superiors, teachers, counsellors and therapists.

- The Master level course intends to equip them with an integrated vision of clinical psychology from a Christian formatory perspective.
- The students will simultaneously register for M.A. Psychology (Specialization Clinical) (IGNOU) so that they can obtain a nationally recognised Post-graduate degree.
- Together with this course, they will follow 12 modules of courses based on Christian anthropology and formation.
- The students will be given personal Vocational Growth Sessions as well as clinical experience in different institutions.
- They will learn five different therapies like NLP, AMR, Gestalt, REBT, and Psychodynamic Therapy.

• This course aims to develop the skills of diagnosis and psychotherapy mainly from a psychodynamic perspective.

One Year Residential Course for Formators (CFC XXVI) 15 June 2020 to 15 March 2021

CFC course is the special programme of Denahalaya designed for those in facilitatory positions, and people who serve others – they may be formation personnel (religious & priestly formators), superiors, spiritual guides, or those in any helping position, those currently engaged in such work, or aspiring to do so. The course deals with the skills and theories aimed at making the participants in both assessment and accompaniment of the future students.

- The students will be given personal Vocational Growth Sessions as well as clinical experience in different institutions.
- They will learn five different therapies like NLP, AMR, Gestalt, REBT, and Psychodynamic Therapy.
- This course aims to develop the skills of diagnosis and psychotherapy mainly from a psychodynamic perspective.

Short Course for FormatorsMay 4 - May 24, 2020 (three weeks)

This is a three week course specially designed for formators. It attempts at dealing with the question of how freedom to respond responsibly to one's vocation is hampered by certain internal psychological blocks that can affect his or her motivation. The course deals with the issue of facilitating psychospiritual growth by healing and growth-oriented helping techniques of counselling and spiritual direction.
